Self-Management Plan

⇒ Weigh yourself in the morning ⇒ Eat low salt food **EVERYDAY:** ⇒ Take your medications ⇒ Balance activity with rest periods Green Flags — All Clear 📜 What this means: If you have: You symptoms are under control No shortness of breath Continue to take your medications as ordered No chest pain or chest tightness Follow healthy eating habits No weakness Keep all physician appointments BP less than 140-90 (or lower if you have Diabetes, Kidney Disease, or Heart Failure HbA1c < 7% if you are a Diabetic LDL <100 mg/dl Ability to do usual activities Keep up the great work! What this means: Yellow Flags — Caution If you have any of the following: Your symptoms may indicate that you Shortness of breath need an adjustment of your medications Swelling of your feet, ankles, legs or stomach Call your doctor or nurse Fatigue or lack of energy **Dizziness** Call your doctor, nurse, or home health nurse if An uneasy feeling—you know something is not symptoms do not improve. Difficulty breathing when lying down or you sleep Name: sitting up with extra pillows Chest pain or heaviness Number: Instructions: If you notice a Yellow Flag, work closely with your health care team. Red Flags—Stop and Think What this means: If you have: This indicates you need to be seen by a physician Struggling to breathe or have unrelieved shortright away. In an emergency, call 9-1-1 ness of breath while sitting still Physician: Have chest pain not relieved or reoccurs after taking 3 nitro tablets Number: Have confusion or can't think clearly Instructions: In an emergency situation: Call 911 If you notice a Red Flag, call your physician immediately.
