Sue Cameron appointed to Area Agency on Aging & Disabilities of Southwest Washington Advisory Council

Vancouver, Washington, July 26, 2022 — Sue Cameron of Vancouver was recently appointed to the Advisory Council of the Area Agency on Aging & Disabilities of Southwest Washington (AAADSW), representing Clark County. Ms. Cameron has previously served on the Advisory Council and is returning after meeting term limit requirements.

Ms. Cameron has experience in many aspects of community engagement. She has twenty years of public health experience as a department administrator and sanitarian for Tillamook County Health Department. In addition, she has twenty-six years of organizational leadership experience including long-range planning, management of professional staff, support staff, and volunteers. She has written grants for numerous nonprofit health and human services agencies. Ms. Cameron has raised funds for United Way Campaign as well as state and local political campaigns.

The Area Agency on Aging & Disabilities of Southwest Washington is a State-appointed public agency whose mission is to promote independence, choice, well-being, and dignity for persons aged 60 and over, adults with disabilities, and their families through a comprehensive, coordinated system of home and community-based services. The Agency's Advisory Council is made up of six members from Clark County and three members from each of the other four counties it serves.

Ms. Cameron says she will bring her experience on many national, state and local boards including the State Council on Aging to her work on the Advisory Council. She plans to advocate for seniors, insure meal services, transportation, and support for caregivers. Plus, she will encourage new members to get involved and work on the agency plan.
